

## **IMSA and ITE Announce New Traffic Signal Maintenance Handbook**

The International Municipal Signal Association (IMSA) and The Institute of Traffic Engineers (ITE) have published a new Traffic Signal Maintenance Handbook. A project team of traffic signal experts with diverse perspectives - design, construction, operations, and maintenance - were selected to develop a comprehensive, user-friendly handbook. The team included authors of previous traffic signal maintenance handbooks, former state and county traffic engineers, a traffic signal maintenance contractor, and a former local agency traffic signal technician.

The Traffic Signal Maintenance Handbook will assist managers, engineers, maintenance and operations professionals in managing the maintenance of traffic signals. In addition, the handbook provides simple and practical guidelines for establishing and managing a maintenance program within an agencies' available financial and technical resources.

The Handbook includes: risk management; process & procurement procedures; construction and inspection checklists; preventive maintenance; responsive maintenance; design modification; management of the asset; development of a customized maintenance plan; measures of performance, MUTCD and OSHA requirements and work force development.
